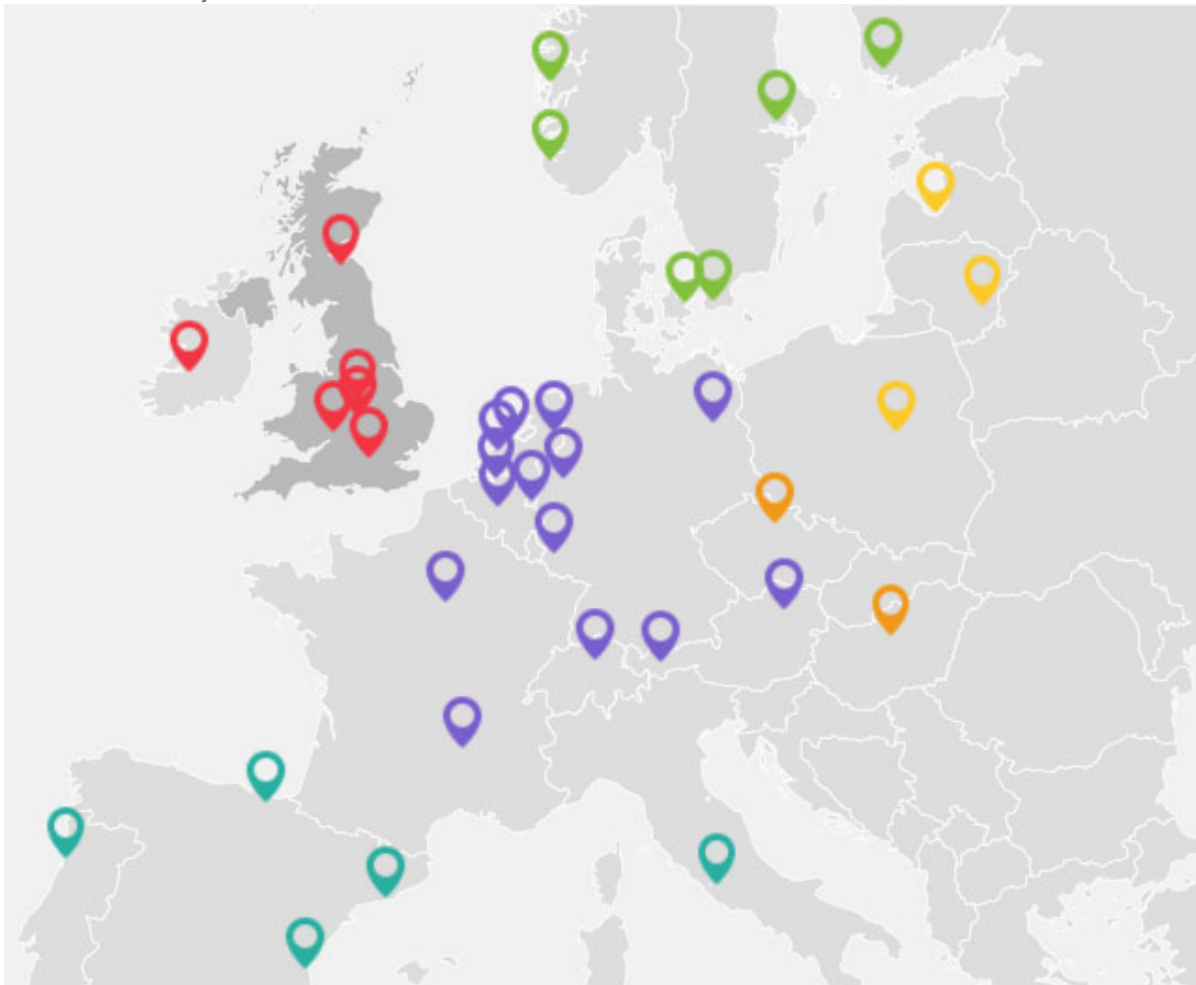

In August 1989 EAIR became an independent membership association in higher education.

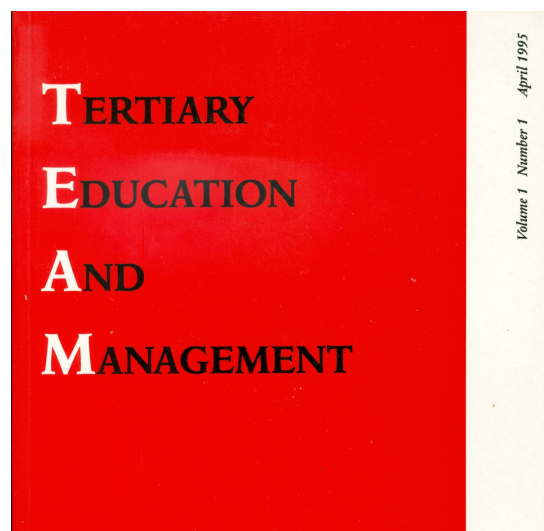
The **EAIR members** have contributed their dedication, expertise and professionalism in the relationship between research, policy and practice in higher education.

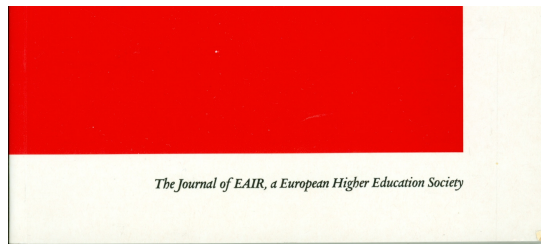

This was one of a series of presentations at EAIR Forums made by Burton R. Clark. If you have not registered for the 39th EAIR Forum Porto 2017
please do so before the early bird deadline on 1st July 2017

The Forum fees for the early bird deadline (before 1 July 2017) are:

Non-member – € 710

For EAIR members who have paid their membership fees:

- * Full members € 510
- * Student members € 255
- * Emeritus members € 340
- * Forum speakers (age 35 and below) € 255 (paid full/student membership fees)

Not a member yet:

- * Forum fees full membership € 675
- * Forum fees student membership – € 337.50
- * Forum fees Emeritus membership – € 450
- * Forum fees accepted as Forum Speaker (35 years and younger) – € 420
- * Forum fees accepted Forum Speaker (a Student in HE) – € 337.50

The Forum registration fee includes entrance to all daily presentation sessions, Forum Welcome reception, Forum Social dinner, all daily lunches & coffee/tea breaks and Forum Farewell lunch.

There is an additional € 14.00 for the administration costs per registration.

AFTER the early bird deadline of 1 JULY 2017 (23:59 CEST) an additional EURO € 55 for late registration will be charged to the Forum registration fee.

If you have more than five (5) registrations you may qualify for an EAIR Corporate membership. The 5th person gets a membership fee waiver of Euro € 165. You will be given one invoice of the total amount of a Corporate registration. Please contact the EAIR Secretariat if you have questions.
